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Dear Alisa and Colleagues,

On behalf of the Samoan study I approve the manuscript. I also send along these comments for your attention.

1. in Table S1 in the row for the Samoa study the FG source indicates plasma. That is incorrect, it was serum.
2. in Table S3 and elsewhere the acronym 'SAS' is used whereas in Tables S1 and S2 the word 'Samoan' is used. Best to be consistent with 'Samoan'.
3. On title page I ask to add my middle initial 'T.', and to edit my affiliation from 'Department of Epidemiology, Brown University School of Public Health, Providence, RI, 02903, USA', to (corrections in bold) '**International Health Institute and** Department of Epidemiology, Brown University School of Public Health, Providence, RI, **02912**, USA'.

It is great to see the Samoan data included, and I thank you for the work that made this report possible.
